
Sample Book Club Discussion Questions for YOU CAN GO HOME NOW by Michael Elias

- Revenge is an important theme in the book. Do you think Nina's actions were justified?

- Any impressions or thoughts about the portrayals of law enforcement in *You Can Go Home Now?*
- Nina worries that her rage might be ebbing. Discuss.
- Do you agree that we embrace revenge in our culture? Is the death penalty revenge or justice?
- Did you find the ending satisfying, did you feel justice was served?
- What does the title of the book mean to you?
- If you were a casting agent, which actor would be your ideal Nina Karim?
